





7.1.5 Institution is committed to maintenance of cleanliness, sanitation, green cover and providing a pollution free healthy environment.

- 1. Planting of trees and other vegetation: Numerous trees and other vegetation have been planted throughout the campus in various places. The institution does a good job of protecting and conserving these trees and plants, which greatly contribute to the campus's greenery.
- 2. Upkeep of flower gardens: Various unoccupied spots on and around the campus have had flowers of various sorts planted in pots. Regular maintenance, mowing, and watering are performed on these blooms.
- 3. The placement of various trash cans within each building and throughout the campus allows for efficient garbage management. Different garbage containers (dry waste, wet waste, and electronic waste) are stored on every floor of each block of the Institute to help keep the Institute's wastes well-segregated.
- 4. On campus, smoking is categorically forbidden and is punishable by fines. Around the campus, information boards are erected to promote cleaning and hygiene.
- 5. Throughout each year, there is a regular campus cleanliness push. The Campus Management Cell takes the initiative to organise cleanliness drives in which faculty, staff, and students are divided into groups and given specific tasks to complete in order to clean the campus, including cleaning all of the rooms, bathrooms, steps, railings, floors, windows, drains, and walls of the campus buildings. The Institution supplies and purchases the cleaning supplies. On the day of campus cleaning, all faculty, staff, and students are given a complimentary lunch.
- 6. The Swachh Bharat Cell was established by the Institution in response to the Swachh Bharat Mission, which was announced by the Prime Minister
