Response:

The College Governing Council decided to establish several Committees to guarantee efficient academics and administrative operations, as well as to encourage student activity and knowledge growth. The Governing Council delegates all policy-based academic and non-academic decisions to the college running Committees. Efforts are always made to implement and execute all plans and decisions effectively keeping in mind the students' welfare and the institution's overall development. The Governing Council creates new committees/cells as needed. Committees/cells/Clubs are made up of faculty members, student representatives, and non-teaching staff members who participate in planning and carrying out all the operations. Contributions of IQAC: During IQAC meetings, extensive discussions were conducted to offer additional courses through alternative teaching and learning pathways via Curriculum Committee and Skill Development Center.
