


Fig: Process of Feedback and action taken




Figure 1: Process of Feedback Analysis of Stakeholders

The steps adopted in the mandatory feedback process are:


- i) Organizing workshops to prepare the add on program.






Action taken of Teachers feedback on Syllabus:
